- Federal Law Panel – Representatives from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Office of Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the U.S. Attorney's Office in New Hampshire will discuss the applicability and enforcement of the Fair Housing Act, the Americans with Disabilities Act, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
- State Resources Panel – Leadership professionals of the New Hampshire Office of the Long-term Care Ombudsman, the New Hampshire Association of Residential Care Homes, the New Hampshire Health Care Association and the Crotched Mountain Foundation will present information about their organizations and resources and services to facilities and/or facility residents.
- State Law and Legal Resources Panel – Attorneys from New Hampshire Legal Assistance, the Disability Rights Center – NH and the New Hampshire Department of Justice will speak about the services they provide to facility residents and discuss recent cases.
